PART-TIME FIREFIGHTER/EMT/PARAMEDIC

The Miami Valley Fire District is accepting applications for the position of Part-time Firefighter/EMT/Paramedic. The Miami Valley Fire District serves the communities of Miamisburg and Miami Township which encompasses a jurisdiction of 35 square miles and a residential population of 50,000.

The Part-time Firefighter/EMT/Paramedic is assigned to fire and medic apparatus as directed by the Lieutenant or Battalion Chief to protect life and property by performing firefighting, emergency medical services, hazardous materials operations, and technical rescue. The Part-time Firefighter/EMT/Paramedic works in conjunction with Full-time Career Firefighter/Paramedics and under the general supervision of a Fire Lieutenant or Officer-in-Charge.

The regular schedule consists of a 24-hour shift every six days, not to exceed 1,500 hours annually. The wage scale is \$15.47 to \$19.37 per hour by certification level listed below.

Firefighter/EMT - \$15.47 to \$17.43
Firefighter/Paramedic - \$17.44 to \$19.37

Minimum qualifications at the time of application include: 1) possession of an Ohio EMT Certification, 2) possession of an Ohio 240-hour Firefighter Certification, 3) possession of a valid Ohio driver's license, 4) successfully complete NTN entry level written testing and 5) possess a CPAT certification. Contact the Miami Valley Fire & EMS Alliance to arrange for NTN entry level written testing.

To be considered, applicants must 1) provide proof of required certifications 2) complete application/personal history questionnaire with resume, and 3) submit to ATTN: Fire Chief, Miami Valley Fire District, 2710 Lyons Road, Miamisburg, Oh 45342.
