

FIRE HAZARDS IN THE HOME

- Does a grown-up always stay in the kitchen when food is cooking on the stove?
 yes (3 points) no (1 point)
- If people smoke, do they use large, deep non-tip ashtrays?

- Are matches and lighters locked up high, away from children?
 yes (3 points)
 no (1 point)
- Are space heaters at least three feet away from walls, furniture, or anything that can burn?

- Are candle holders in a safe place where they can't be knocked over? (Remember: leave candles to grown-ups.)

- Do grown-ups blow out candles when they leave the room or go to bed?
 yes (3 points) no (1 point)




- Do you test your smoke alarms once a month? (Have a grown-up push the test button to check if the batteries are okay.)
